Now we have a Vespa GTS 300ie, it is a 278cc fuel injected water cooled 4 stroke with ABS and traction control. (very hi tec)

I finally settled on a Hydro Trail from Easy Lifter. This at first glance looks like a trailer but it is fixed and the wheels swivel like a supermarket trolley.



You jack it up take off the wheels and drop it down to put the scooter on then jack it back up and put the wheels on. I had a few alterations to do on the wheel clamps just to make it more secure and easy for me to put on and off.

Picking it up from Newark was a bit tricky, the parking was tight and we did not know how to fix it on, but now its sorted.
